With this high-quality data, we see less effort in describing research output and materials, improved discovery and delivery, and a better connection between all stakeholders, all leading to an enhanced knowledge creation circle. During this session, Dr. Kaschte will consider how the use of linked data can help with both global and local visibility of library resources, as well as looking at the role that Artificial Intelligence (AI) and machine learning can play.</p>
